SWIMMING MANAWATU OPEN CHAMPIONSHIPS 2020 MEET CONDITIONS



- **Entry via the SNZ Database, closing date for entries is 23:00 21 February 2020**
- **Entry fees - \$7.50 per event.** Payment is to be made through the SNZ database at the time of entry.
- Pool will be open from 8.15am and 1.45pm – spectators free
- Sprint lanes 1 and 7 for the last 20 minutes of warm up
- No water is available for warm up or warm down during the sessions
- 400m events may be restricted to fastest 28 swimmers only.
- All events, with the exception of the 50m Freestyle events, will be swum as Timed Finals.
- SNZ Policy 008 will apply. Scratchings from all events, excluding the 50m Freestyle heats, must be received before the conclusion of the preceding session. For the 800m and 1500m scratchings must be received Thursday night. The scratching penalty fee is \$25.00. The protest fee is \$100.00
- Refunds will be made up to 24 February 2020, thereafter on production of a medical certificate presented on the day.
- Age as at first day of meet.
- Swimming Manawatu reserves the right to alter the programme and limit entries should the need arise.
- Times must be supplied for NT entries within 48 hours of the psych sheets being circulated or the swimmer will be withdrawn from the meet.
- An official's break may be held half way through each session.
- Medals will be awarded for first, second and third places. A same gender representative may stand in to collect a medal if the recipient is unavailable. Medals may be collected prior to the presentation

time if the swimmer is leaving the complex. If there is no swimmer or representative at hand the medal will not be presented.

- **Manawatu trophies awarded:** 50m ladies and men's cups; Harkess Cup – Premier Club; Rush Cup; Hodges Cup
- **Please note: results for events 7, 8, 19, 20, 23, 24, 33, 34, 37, 38 will be published in age groups of 10 years and under, 11-12 years, 13-14 years, 15 years and over, and Open age group for Para swimmers (Open Para).**
- Time trials (\$15.00 fee) may be accepted at the discretion of the Race Secretary but only if lane space is available – heats will not be reseeded. Applications will be accepted on a first in basis.
- Meet conducted under FINA, SNZ & Para rules.
- All participants must agree to comply with the sports anti-doping rules
- An official photographer may be present at the event.
